Characterization Writing Assignment

Now that we've spent time learning how to identify a analyse each of the characters in the stories we've been studying, and characterizing them based on their physical and personality traits, you are going to choose **one** of the characters from our most recent stories (*Priscilla and the Wimps or The Tiniest Guitar in the World*) and assess them in a thoroughly developed, strongly supported paragraph.

In choosing Priscilla from, "Priscilla and the Wimps" or Donald from, "The Tiniest Guitar in the World", you will explain how they are a misunderstood character.

Your paragraph must follow the PPA structure:

P = Premise – claim/thesis P = Proof – supporting evidence from text A = Analysis – explanation/ so what?

**Remember: Characters are characterized by:

- 1. What they say and do
- 2. What other characters say or think about them
- 3. What the narrator says about them

Furthermore, your paragraph must be structured with an intro, a body, and a conclusion.

Format for your assignment (If you decide to type it.)

- Name, date, title (You need to come up with a creative title)
- Font size between 10-12, double spaced, black colour, clean fonts style (i.e. Cambria, Times New Roman, Aria)
- Margins (normal width default 2.54cms on all sides)

Your assignment can also be hand written.

Word Minimum – 100 words

Grading:

- 1. Were you able to clearly use the PPA format of explaining your claims? (10)
- 2. Do you have a brief introduction, body and conclusion? (4)
- 3. Did you use grammar, spelling, and punctuation correctly in your paragraph? (3)
- 4. Did you correctly follow the formatting instructions correctly? (3)
